Rationale

The most important grape of France's Northern Rhône Valley and the red variety that drives the wine industry of Australia, where it is known as "Shiraz," Syrah is one of the most talked-about and widely enjoyed of all red wines globally. The synergy between a growing demand for red Rhône-style wines and ongoing excitement from producers is spurring production of excellent wines in the Golden State as well. No longer the domain of the cognoscenti, Syrah and Syrah-based wines are becoming ever more popular at home and in restaurants. Is this because it quenches a thirst for big red wines? Or because of the accessibility of its natural bold flavors? Or because it blends easily with related Mediterranean grapes and plays so well with them in Southern Rhone blends?

Southern Rhône Red Blend refers to a wide range of grape varieties often blended together to make wines in the southern reaches of the Rhône Valley in the south of France. While the blend could theoretically consist of any of a wide range of grape varieties, it is usually made up of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre, in varying proportions, typically with Grenache and Syrah as the dominant partners.

Beckmen Vineyards began after Tom and Judy Beckmen left their innovative electronic music company Roland Corp. With youngest son Steve as Winemaker, and oldest son Jeff joining as Director of Sales, their wines are crafted almost exclusively from our two vineyards, the Thomas and Judith Beckmen Estate Vineyard in Los Olivos District AVA and Purisima Mountain Vineyard in Ballard Canyon AVA.
