Rationale

Pinot Noir is capable of some of the most exquisite examples of red wine imaginable. Unfortunately, in many spots globally, it is at the mercy of fickle weather and, as such, less than spectacular harvests making it one of the most challenging grape varieties to produce.

California's moderate Mediterranean-like weather combined with cool coastal enclaves -- from Anderson Valley in the north to Santa Barbara in the south -- provides Pinot Noir growers more security in their efforts to cultivate this most difficult of grape varieties.

The 'true' Sonoma Coast lies in the far western reaches of the county, where the climate is ideal for Pinot Noir. The frigid waters of the Pacific generate breezes that transport fog inland during summer and result in cool, mild growing conditions. Well-architected, fruit-filled Pinot Noirs are typified by plum, blackberry, cherry, and wild berry flavors, well-framed by toasty notes, conifer, and minerality.

With over 37 years of farming and winemaking on the True Sonoma Coast, David Hirsch's accumulated wisdom pioneered this now-signature area of California's wine coastline. San Andreas Fault is Hirsch Vineyards' signature Pinot Noir and is crafted to represent the entirety of this multifaceted vineyard. The 2018 San Andreas Fault has fruit from 45 distinct farming blocks. This flagship wine from Hirsch represents the summation of the winery's complex vineyard.
